

Greensand Way to Hunton

7 miles



1. Start at the Bench next to the Tickled Trout public house.
Walk down the hill (Yalding direction) and at the bend by Vale House, take the slip road uphill past 5 houses grouped together. At the top there is a gate which you need to pass through, and head straight across the field to a stile in the hedge row that brings you into a private car park.
2. Cross over the road (Hunt Street) and at Marshall's Cottages take the footpath into the raspberry fields. (NB, sometimes the covers on the raspberries prevent direct access on the footpath, but it can be easily reached by walking around the perimeter of the field instead) When you reach the road (Small Profits) cross straight over into the fruit fields the other side and turn left. There is a stile and also a kissing gate a little further up through the hedge line to choose from, into the wood yard which then leads onto Yalding Hill. Cross over the road and head downhill.
3. The footpath is well signposted here and leads you horizontally across the field. Upon reaching the hedge line you are on a byway. Turn right downhill for a short walk until you reach the Greensand Way and take that in the direction of Buston Manor and Malice Wood. However, at the number 72 on the map it turns uphill but do not take this route, instead follow the normal footpath down to the Old Rectory and onto a tarmac track through orchards leading down to the bottom of Hunton Hill.
4. Walk uphill on Hunton Hill (no pavement), crossing over Heath Road and onto Dean Street.

5. Just before The Horseshoes pub (refreshments?) take the footpath on your left that meets up with Wilsons Lane. On Gallants Lane turn right and then take the footpath on your left. This leads you to West Farleigh Green, where upon walk down Ewell Lane to return to the bench.
