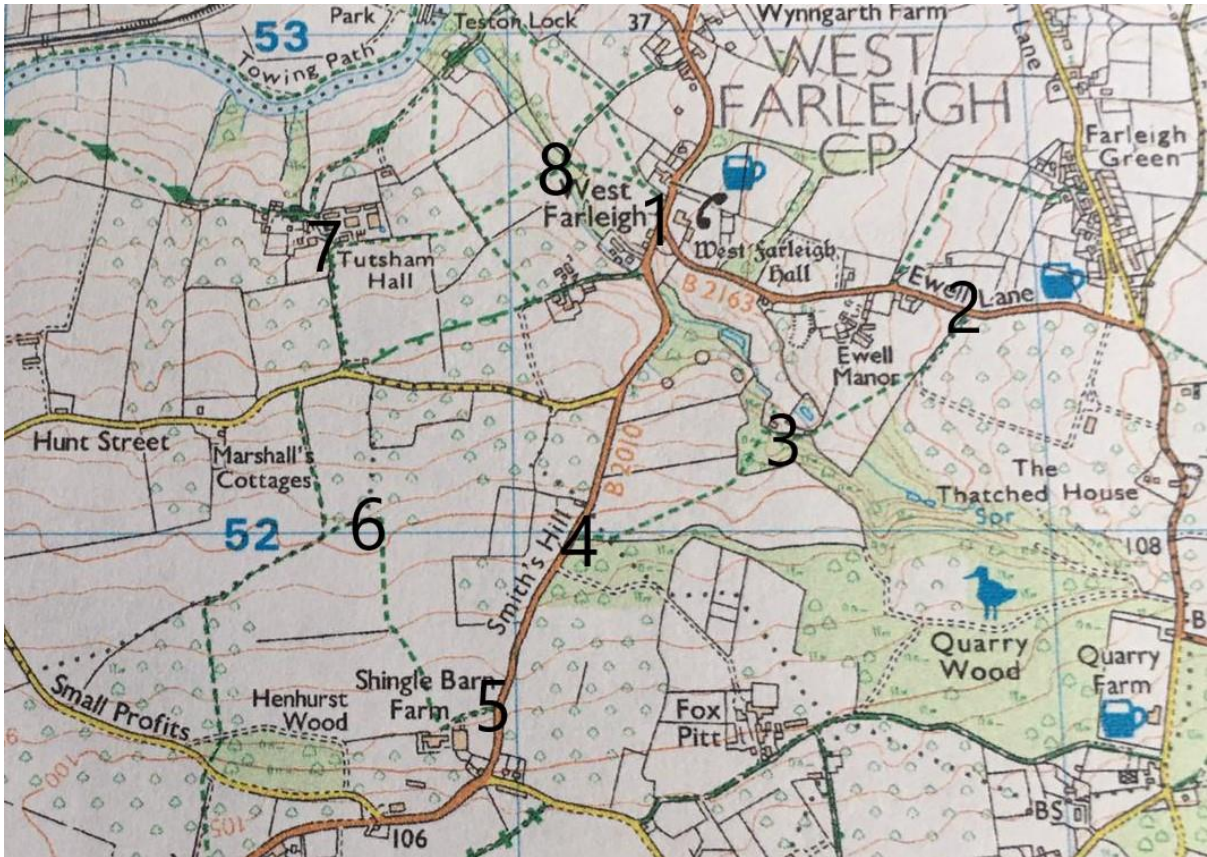


## Quarry Wood and Shingle Barn

2 miles



Note: This walk has some road walking sections.

1. Start at the bench next to the Tickled Trout public house. Head up Ewell Lane, past Ewell Manor, Jewelutra and the cottages on your right hand side, until you reach a footpath leading into an apple orchard.
2. Walk through the apple orchard, against the hedgerow on your right, until you reach the footpath just before a large Oak tree (half way along the field). Follow this through into another field and a small private orchard. Continue downhill towards the woodland of Quarry Wood. The gate is in the right hand corner at the bottom.
3. Continue behind the cattle shed and take the stile into Quarry Wood. Go uphill through 'Chestnut Walk' until you reach a stile into an open field. Walk diagonally across the field to Smith's Hill and a pedestrian gate to exit.
4. Continue up the road until you reach the entrance to Shingle Barn Estate on your right, this is also the footpath.
5. Head along the fence line until the start of the next footpath. There is usually a picnic bench here and it is a fantastic view across to the other side of the valley. Walk downhill across the field.
6. The next section walks through Clock House Farm raspberry fields. Next to the hedge, continue downhill until you reach Hunt street. Cross over the road and continue down towards Tutsham Hall on their private road.

7. Just before the houses on the right, take the footpath between 2 fields. At the next fence line, continue in a straight line down towards the Ewell Stream.
8. In the woodland there are 2 kissing gates, take the one on the right which will return you into the field in front of the Bench.
